1. Never exceed a product’s design limits.
2. Always move to a safe, controlled condition.
3. Always keep safety devices armed when equipment is placed into service.
4. Always adhere to safe work practices and procedures.
5. Always do a job that meets or exceeds the Department’s expectations.
6. Always comply with environmental, health and safety regulations.
7. Always refer to Utilities Safety Programs and Procedures requirements.
8. Always address abnormal conditions and procedures.
9. Never bypass equipment safety features when equipment is placed into service.
10. Always involve the right people in critical decision making.
11. Always use the right tools for the job.
